

My practice is led by material, process and meaning. I examine the properties of the clay material through a process of breaking and reassembling my pieces, twisting, pulling clay and mixing it with eclectic components. I explore how ceramics can mirror the human condition, how we respond to the passing of time, our legacy and loss. The cracks in the pieces, the lines of stress and unanticipated results from firings, explores our duality between fragility and resilience. The stillness of the final pieces and apparent strength are deceptive and hide an accumulation of distorted layers and opened scars.
