PERSONAL PROFILE

Darren trained in Fashion Textiles, specialising in hand knit. He taught himself free machine embroidery whilst teaching art and textiles in secondary and further education. His embroideries combine his love of the rich visual qualities of fabric with the linear stitch of the sewing machine. They are further embellished with satin stitch, beads and sequins to enrich their surface. His current work is largely inspired by the stylised photographs used to illustrate the knitting patterns in his collection of 1940's Stitchcraft magazines. Referencing the period he uses found vintage embroidery, handkerchiefs and recycled fabrics to suggest personal narratives. Darren is delighted to have been selected as one of the 26 designer makers taking part in the Crafts Council Hothouse 2019 programme.
