Crafts Council Gallery is a Grade II listed, architecturally restored venue in the heart of Central London.

From Methodist Chapel to Modern Event Space

Originally built as a 19th century congregational Methodist chapel, it has been re-imagined and re-designed by AOC Architects.

Outside, the building boasts an impressive white façade with steps, arched windows, ionic columns and a gated, illuminated forecourt with occasional seating.

Step inside, the gallery provides a warm and flexible space suitable for hosting events including receptions, dinners, product launches, brand activations, award ceremonies, photo and film shoots, talks and exhibitions.

Available to hire on a dry hire basis, it can accommodate up to 180 standing and 140 seated.

In addition, on the first floor, flexible workshop and meeting spaces are available, either as part of the gallery hire or as standalone rooms. These versatile spaces are perfect for meetings, strategy sessions, training, client presentations, creative workshops and breakout activities.



The Gallery

Inside, visitors are welcomed by a naturally daylight lobby, separated from the event space by a glass window and an arch-framed set of doors.

The open plan event space features restored original parquet flooring, with clay plastered walls suitable for hanging. The room is filled with assimilated daylight by a calming central light box and adjustable, museum quality track lighting installed by art lighting specialists, TM Lighting.

To the side of the event space is a small breakout or storage space. At the front is a library area furnished by furniture maker Sebastian Cox with chestnut lined walls complemented by ash shelving, ideal for hosting intimate talks, meetings and workshops.



Capacities

- Standing – up to 180 people
- Theatre-style – up to 120 people
- Meeting – up to 48 people
- Dining – up to 140 people

All capacities depend on the space layout.

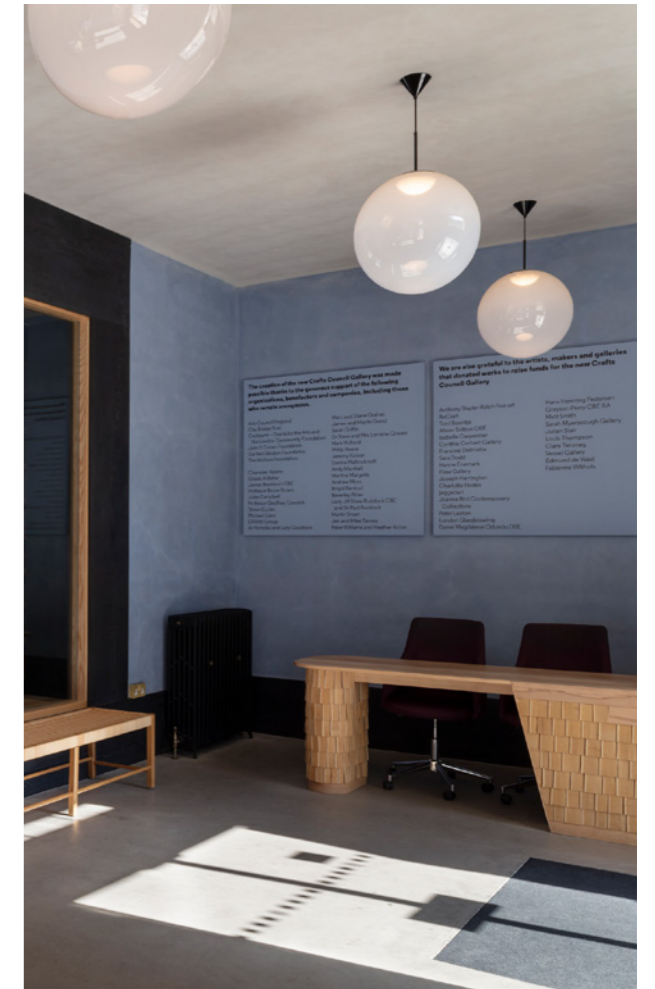

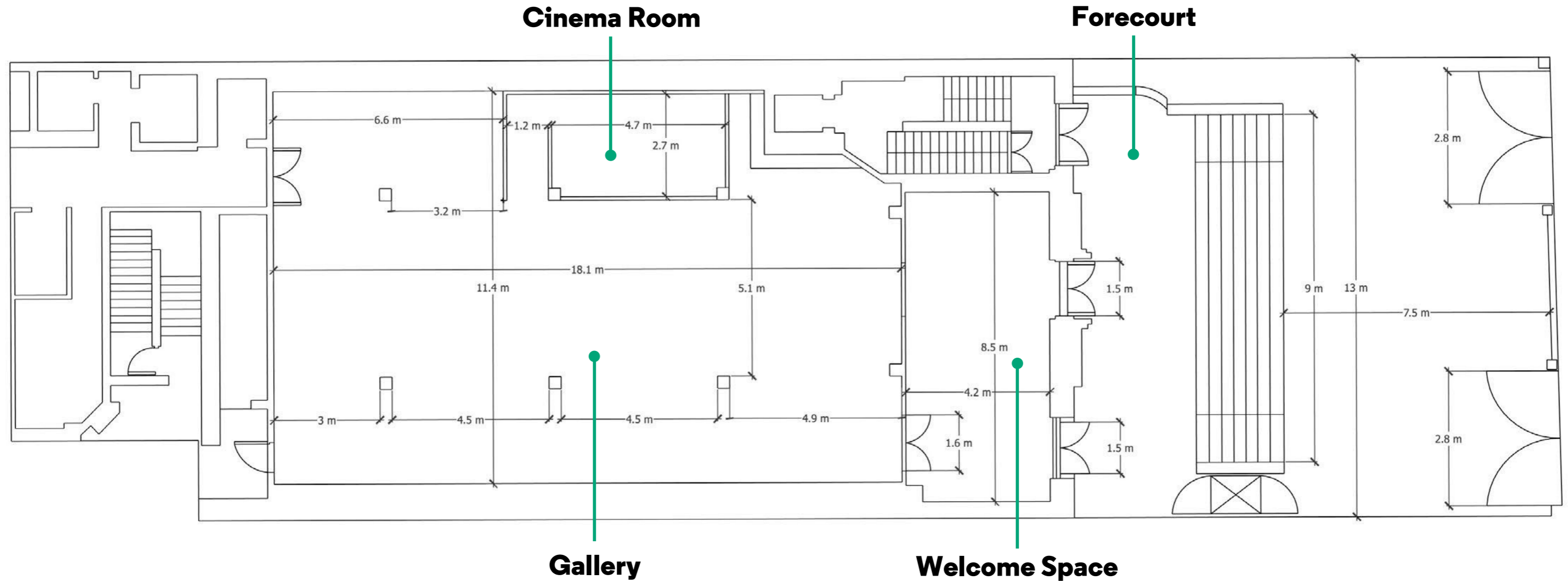

Flexible Workshop & Meeting Spaces

Our newly refurbished meeting rooms and workshop spaces above the gallery offer a contemporary setting for collaborative work, breakout sessions, meetings, workshops and small gatherings. Three boardroom-style meeting rooms are available for up to 12 people.

The adjoining workshop space is designed for flexibility, featuring eight handcrafted foldable oak tables and chairs made from recycled materials. It can be arranged in theatre, boardroom, or classroom layouts.

All spaces are equipped with screens and air conditioning, and can be hired individually or alongside the gallery. A kitchenette is available for self-service tea and coffee or can be provided at an additional cost. Clients are welcome to bring in external catering.

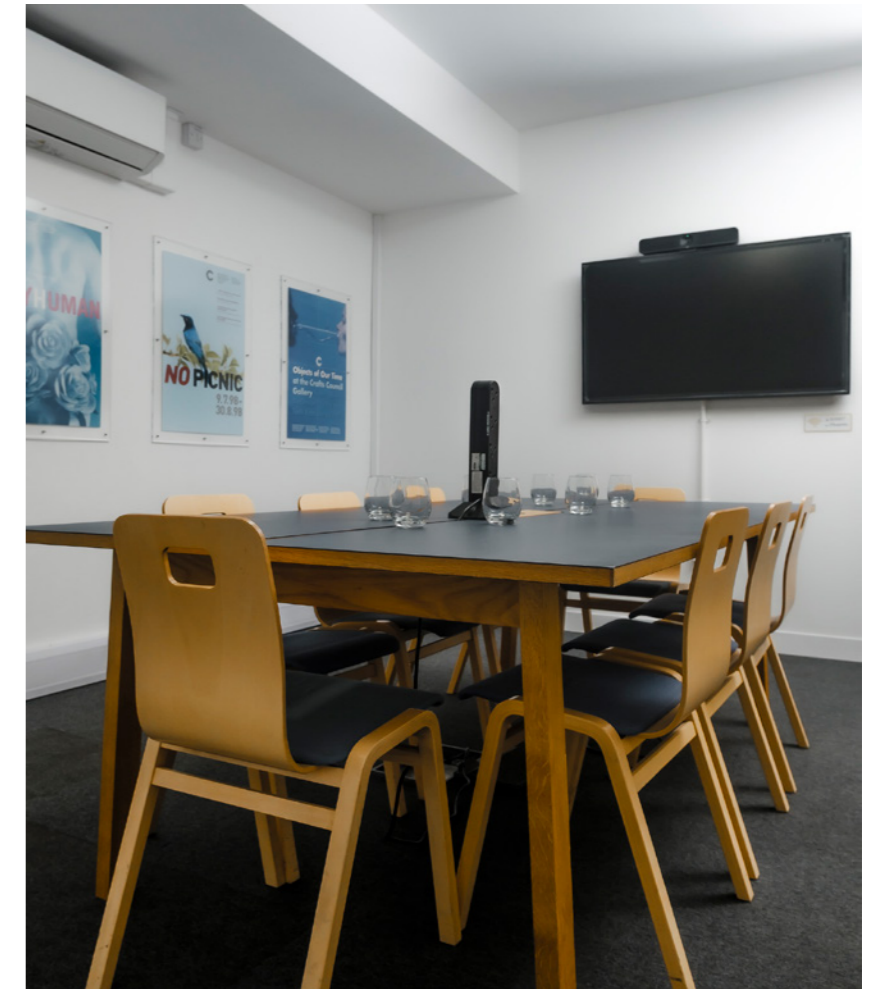

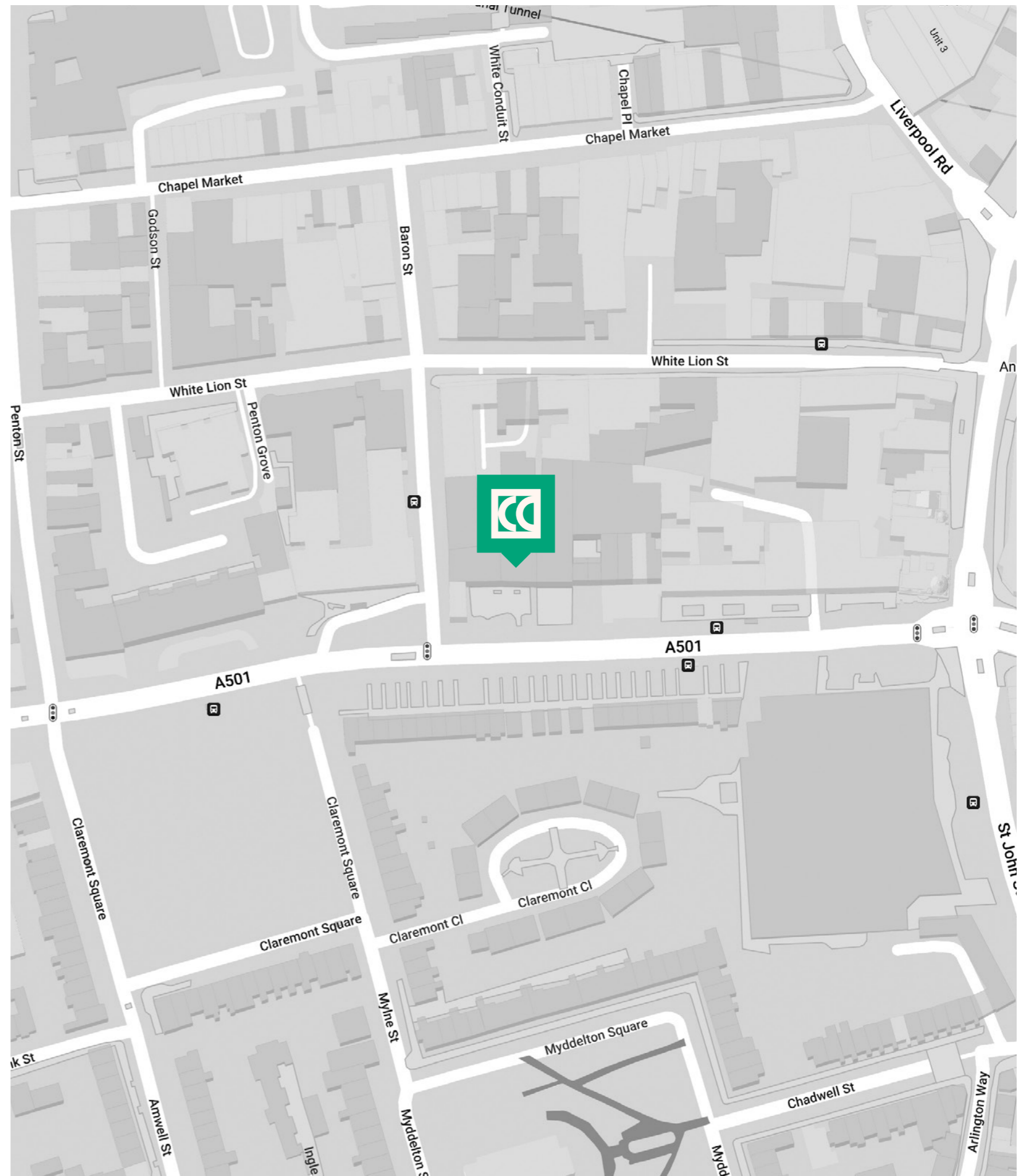
