## **Craft practice**

I established my mosaic studio in Shrewsbury, Shropshire in April 2017 in the stables of a Georgian townhouse once owned by the Industrial Revolution Ironmaster, William Hazeldine. In this historic courtyard are also textile designers, artists and a carpenter.

I have space to design and make mosaics, meet clients to discuss commissions and I also deliver mosaic workshops for adults. In addition, I share my love of art and design through working as an Artist in Residence in primary schools and as part of the museum education team at Shrewsbury Museum & Art Gallery.

My mosaic craft practice has developed from my original training as a jeweller and silversmith at Birmingham School of Jewellery and my approach to making is very much based on gem-setting skills rather than the picassiette style of broken tile and ceramics. Other influences come from an interest in textiles and surface pattern, both historic and from other cultures. Current themes include the concept of mosaic floristry,



decorative garden stakes to add focal points in garden borders and exploring reflective coloured surfaces created by stained glass and mirrors. I am also developing a range of wall panels and garden stakes influenced by 1930s graphic designs and carpets of tiles.

In 2018 my work was accepted into the Shropshire Guild of Contemporary Craft and is now shown at various selling events and galleries throughout the year.
