## **ABOUT THE ARTIST**

Pipistrelle is a creator of unique sculptural ceramics and illustration, taking inspiration from natural curiosities. Her ceramic pieces are usually sculptural and decorative and are sometimes given a function through their form. Pipistrelle is best known for her hand-sculpted mushroom jewellery dish ornaments and sea creature dishes and platters, as well as a range of nature inspired homeware and jewellery. The artist makes most of her work from porcelain and finishes with a variety of glazes, oxides and lustres.

Pipistrelle grew up in South Wales, and now lives and works in Bristol. The artist has a fine art background with a specialism in printmaking, but finds she can better express her love of all things weird and wonderful in nature through ceramics. She enjoys working with clay as it's so tactile with infinite possibilities and opportunities to learn new techniques. Pipistrelle rekindled her love of playing with clay by attending classes at Maze studios. Six years later she's still hooked, and now has a studio space at Maze. Pipistrelle currently sells her ceramics on Etsy as well as at arts and crafts markets in the South West, e.g. the Frome Independent.
